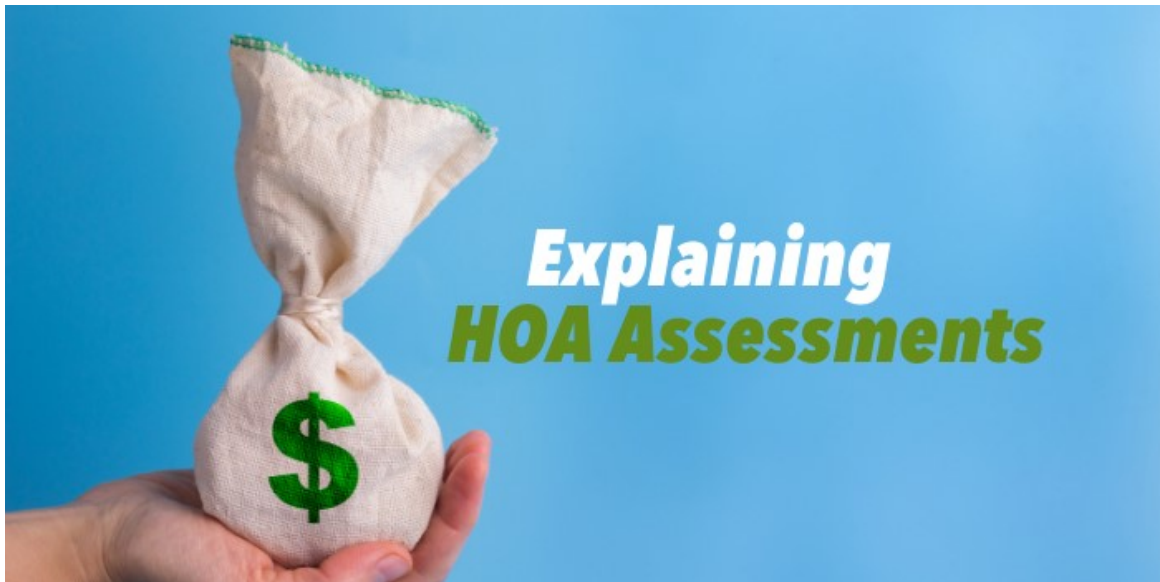

2023 Annual Assessment

The Ahwatukee Board of Management, Board of Directors voted for a 3.9% increase in the assessment for 2023. The result is \$237.00 for the annual assessment, a \$9.00 increase equaling .75 cents

What does my assessment cover?

The Board meets regularly to make business decisions on matters that affect any large corporation. The annual assessment provides for just over 50% of the ABM's annual operating budget. The balance of the budget is comprised of administrative fees and user fees from the amenities. Ahwatukee's common areas include approximately 106

a month. The Board is mindful that we are all experiencing increased costs and as such, kept the increase as low as possible.

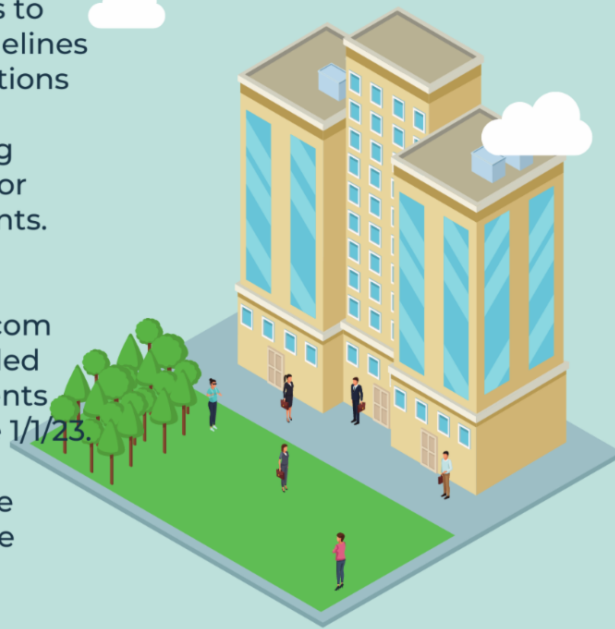

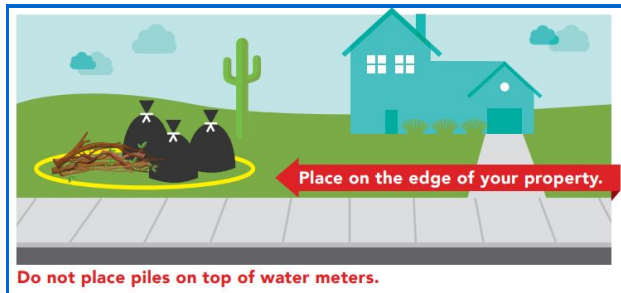

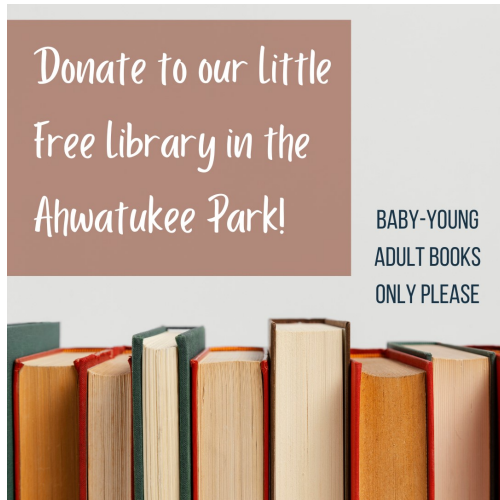

Purpose:
The blended learning course equips students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid, breathing, and cardiac emergencies involving adults, children and infants.

Format:

- Blended learning format (the online portion must be completed prior to attending the Instructor-led skills session)
- Instructor-led skills session

Upon successful completion:
A valid 2 year digital certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED will be issued.

Lifeguarding
on Saturday, March 18th or Saturday, May 14th
from 8:00am-4:00pm
for \$199

Purpose:
Provides entry-level participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until EMS personnel take over.
Prerequisites: Minimum age: 15 years; Swim 300 yards continuously; Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs; Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface dive to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, exit the water without using steps or a ladder.

A valid 2 year digital certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED will be issued.

Babysitter's Training and Pediatric First Aid/CPR

Purpose:
This course provides youth who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills; learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe and help children behave; and learn about pediatric first aid/CPR. The recommended age for this course is 11-15 years old.

Format:

- Instructor-led skills session

A valid 2 year digital certificate will be issued.

Purpose:
An abbreviated Lifeguarding course that briefly reviews course information and allows practice of skills and knowledge before testing. Current certification in Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED is required to participate in the review course.

- Instructor-led skills session

Upon successful completion:
A valid 2 year digital certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED will be issued.

Certification classes can be created for a group organization or company at a discounted price for the following courses: Anaphylaxis & Epinephrine Auto-Injector, Asthma Inhaler Training, Bloodborne Pathogens Training, CPR for Professional Rescuers, First Aid for Public Safety Personnel, Lifeguarding, Safety Training for Swim Coaches, Babysitter's Training, Basic Life Support, First Aid/CPR/AED, Wilderness & Remote First Aid, Head/Neck/Muscle/Bone/Joint Injuries & Splinting, and Life-threatening Bleeding and Tourniquet Application.

Did you know that we have a canine ambassador?

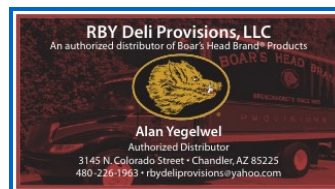
